

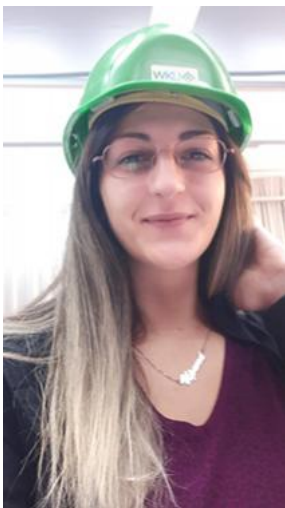

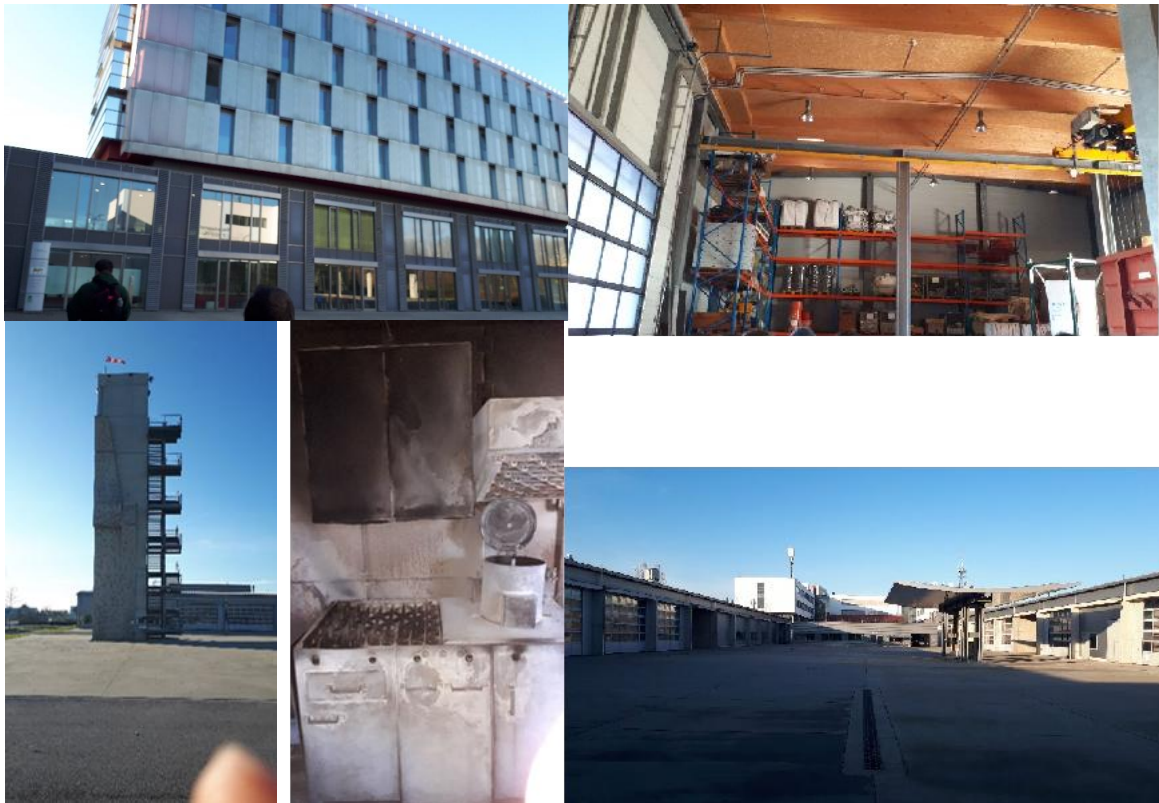
My favorite parts were visits to Incineration plant in Vienna where me and my colleagues saw example of good practice in waste incineration and to Training center in Tulln for disaster management.



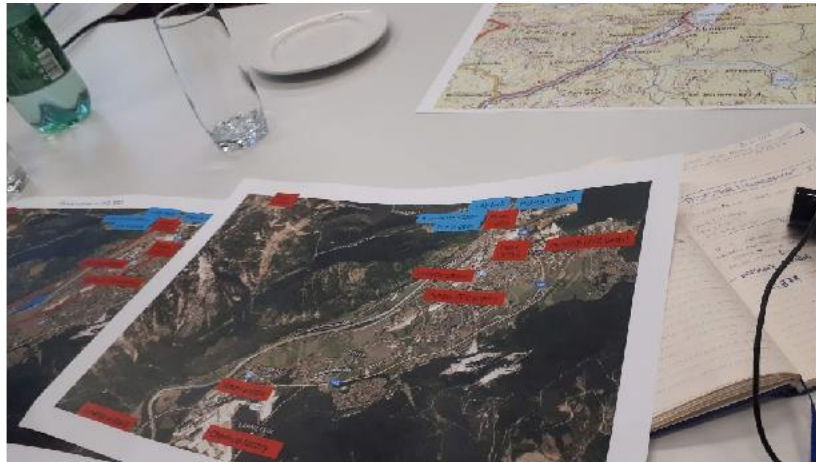
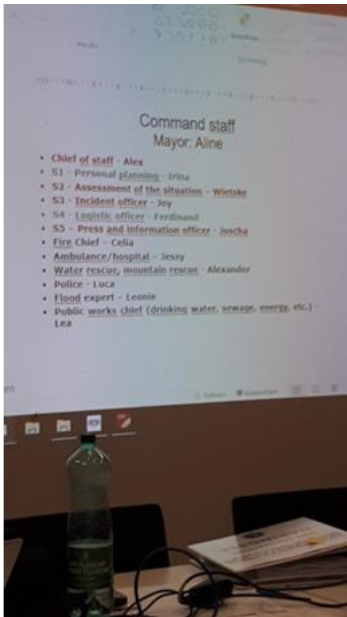
